

INFORMATION FOR THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO ARTICLES 13-14 OF REGULATION (EU) 2016/679

The personal data Controller protects the confidentiality of your personal data and ensures them the right protection against any risk of violation. As for in Regulation of the European Union n.679/2016 (GDPR) and in particular pursuant to articles 13 and 14, below you can find the following information required by law concerning the processing of personal data.

IDENTITY AND CONTACT DATA OF THE PERSONAL DATA CONTROLLER

The personal data controller is CANTORI SRL, headquartered in Osimo 60027 (AN), via delle Querce 15/21, in the person of its pro-tempore legal representative.

PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

In compliance with current legislation on the protection of personal data, the data will be stored, collected and processed by the Controller for the following purposes:

LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING (ART. 6)

Data processing, for the purposes indicated above, it is legitimate as it is attributable to one of the following legal basis indicated in art. 6 of the Regulation:

Legal Basis
The data subject must give the consent to the processing of his or her personal data for the specific purpose
Processing is necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party
Specification: Keeping the applications received before the 25/05/2018 is a legitimate interest of the controller.

TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL DATA ABROAD

The personal data controller has no intention to transfer personal data to a third country of the European Union or to an international organisation. Where it is necessary to transfer to third countries or international organisations, the controller ensures with immediate effect in accordance with the rules governing pursuant to art. 45 (transfers on the basis of an adequacy decision), Art. 46 par.1 (transfers subject to appropriate safeguards), art. 46 par. 2 (standard data protection clauses adopted by the European Commission) GDPR.

STORAGE PERIOD

Personal data will be stored as long as they are necessary for the purposes they were collected, unless the permission it is not withdrawn by the data subject. As from the termination date, personal data will be stored in any case to fulfil the obligations that remain also after the termination of the contract (art. 2220 c.c.); for these purposes the controller will store only the personal data that are necessary for its pursuit.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

In accordance with provisions of the GDPR, you can exercise your rights indicated therein and in particular:

- **Right of access** - The data subject shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data are being processed and, where that is the case, access to the personal data and the following information: purposes of the processing, categories of personal data concerned and storage period, recipients to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed (art. 15, GDPR)
- **Right to rectification** – to obtain, without undue delay, the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and the right to have incomplete personal data completed, including by means of providing a supplementary statement (art. 16 GDPR)
- **Right to erasure** - to obtain, without undue delay, the erasure of personal data concerning you in the cases provided for in GDPR (art. 17 GDPR)
- **Right to restriction of processing** - to obtain from the controller restriction of processing in the cases provided for in GDPR (art. 18 GDPR)
- **Right to data portability** - to receive the personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and have the right to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the controller to which the personal data have been provided in the cases provided for in GDPR (art. 20 GDPR)
- **Right to object** – the right to object to processing of personal data concerning you, unless it is legitimate for the controller to keep on processing data
- **Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority** - the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority for the protection of personal data (www.garanteprivacy.it)

PROCESSING METHODS

The processing of your personal data is carried out by means of the operations indicated in art. 4 of the Privacy Code and art. 4 n. 2) GDPR and more precisely: collection, registration, organization, storage, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

The physical and logical security of your data and, in general, the confidentiality of your personal data, will be guaranteed in any case putting in place all necessary technical and organisational measures adequate to guarantee their security.
